



Lester LaVerne “Verne” Zornes was a Spokane native with deep family roots in the Palouse Region of Eastern Washington. At age 18, this graduate of Lewis & Clark High School signed up to serve his country in the middle of World War Two. He served with the U.S. Army Air Force, but died just 11 days into his first overseas mission. This is the story of his family’s search for answers. Through de-classified records, interviews with those who knew him, Internet archives and dozens of letters he mailed home during his training, they would learn about his sense of humor and adventure, and his love of cars, farming, and family. They would also sort through stories of organized crime, international espionage, and paranormal visions to discover the part he was to play in the largest secret mission in military history.
